**ABC:** Selected congregations for cohort 1; hosted first two hub sessions in August and November 2018; hosting sessions three and four this summer; starting second cohort in August 2019

**Baylor:** Selected congregations in February 2019; hosting first workshop in October 2019 in conjunction with the Baylor Symposium on Faith and Culture. **Boston University SOT:** Selected first cohort of congregations in 2018; hosted first hub meeting in August 2018; second hub gathering in February 2019; selecting second cohort of congregations throughout 2019

**Collegeville Institute:** Selected congregations in August 2018; hosted opening retreat in fall 2018; hosting first meeting in June 2019

**Fuller:** Launching four cohorts in fall 2019; will make online training available to other hubs when it's available (probably in August); willing to host 2-3 people from other hubs at their October 31-November 1<sup>st</sup> summit and at their November 4-5<sup>th</sup> summit – both in Grand Rapids, Michigan.
